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2.1 What is Ethics? 3 I-Levels


Moral: existing values and norms as orientation for decisions and behavior

Ethics: critical adaptation of values and norms as orientation for decisions and behavior in changing context.

- 1. Individual Ethics: me: behavior as individuals
- 2. Interpersonal Ethics: me-you: behavior in direct interactions between individuals/groups
- 3. Institutional Ethics: we-structure: behavior influenced by laws, institutions, structures.



3.2.1 Example Universidad de los Andes Peru: Ethics Across the University

Curriculum & Instruction

• Promotes the integration of ethical reflection in all disciplines and areas of study, with the aim of forming ethical and responsible citizens.

Research & Academic work

• Promotes applied ethics research in different areas of knowledge and fosters dialogue and critical reflection about ethics in the academic work.

Institutional culture

 Seeks to foster a culture of ethics in the university through the promotion of ethical values and behaviors, and by creating spaces for ethical discussion and reflection.

Social responsibility

• Seeks to involve the university community in mission-oriented actions that contribute to sustainable development and social welfare.

Ethics Learning Outcomes ELO: Dimensions

Personal

• Addresses the ethical values and principles in the private life of students (i.e., self knowledge and self-care).

Academic

• Focuses on ethics in research and learning (i.e., academic integrity and research ethics).

Professional

• Addresses ethics in the exercise of the profession (i.e., professional deontology, professional dilemmas).

Citizenship

• Focuses on social responsibility and active participation in society (i.e., human rights, sustainability).



4. Personal and Spiritual Level

- Character education
- Daily university prayer
- Dress code
- Councelling (personal pastoral and psychological support for students)
- Time of teachers for individual dialogues with students



5.1 Ethics Subjects per Faculty

GOUNI Faculties of

- > Arts: e.g. aestetics and ethics, ethics and beauty
- Education: e.g. character education, integrity ethics, intergenerational ethics
- Management and Social Sciences: e.g. business ethics, finance ethics, media ethics



6. Governance Level


The Governance level plays a decisive role on the further way towards an ethical university:

Inside the University:

- > The Senat
- The VC and DVCs
- The Deans and HODs

Outside the University

- The Accreditation bodies (NUC)
- the National and State Authorities (funding, legislations)





7. Finance

- Sufficient and secured funding is the backbone of each institution. It is at the same time one of the main challenges for most of them.
- If any, most of the unethical behaviors in institutions are linked to money and properties.
- Transparency in financial and material matters is an ethical requirement for an ethical university.

Recommendation: Increase fundraising for adequate funding, especially related to <u>decent</u> staff salaries, and transparent financial reporting.



8. Special Services: Directorates

Special Services accross the university play also a key role in the implementation of values of the institution:

 mentorship, parents, entrepreneurship, gender, ICT,

12. Summary: Recommendations

Recommendations for GOUNI:

- 1. <u>Develop further the holistic approach of GOUNI</u> as Ethical University, through its Directorate of Ethics and by trainings with and decisions of Leadership bodies.
- 2. <u>Integrate a compulsory postgraduate course on Applied Ethics</u> in each Department on their subjects as above (1-2 semesters à 2h). Option as certified online course, in cooperation with the Globethics Academy.
- 3. <u>Define at least one Ethical Learning Outcome (ELO)</u> per course assessment and align teaching methods accordingly.
- 4. Strengthen the capacity for student councelling.
- 5. <u>Increase fundraising for adequate funding, especially related to decent staff salaries</u>. Provide transparent financial reporting.
