THE ACTIVITIES OF THE COMMITTEE

- Coordinate and Promote capacity building in grant writing and acquisition
- Organise grant training workshop –more of hands on trainings
- ➤ Assist to review some grant proposals to staff prior to submission for a grant
- Make available grant resources (local and international) to the university community
- Develop guidelines for the management of research grants
- > Templete and forms to fill when you receive grants
- Submit bi-annual reports on the progress of projects
- Follow up of grant received by staff of the university (monitoring and evaluation)
- Produce yearly report of grants submitted or won by staff member for special recognition
- 5% (haft of the 10% of administrative cost of grants) will be awarded to grant winners

OTHER FUNCTIONS OF THE COMMITTEE

- Promotion, facilitation and co-ordination of research activities in the University
- Establish or supervise operational systems for ethical clearance
- Prioritise the interests of the University in the acquisition and reporting of grants
- Setting standards and ensuring effective dissemination of high quality research output from grants (guide the choice of journal to publish research findings from grants)
- Ensure effective distribution and efficient use of research funds

- Promote strategic partnerships between the University and other universities (locally and abroad), relevant industries and business community to attract grants
- Liaising between the University and funding agencies and build strategic partnerships between such agencies and the University
- The registration, protection, patenting and commercialisation of intellectual property



FOURTH CALL FOR AFRICA-UNINET RESEARCH COOPERATION PROJECTS | 1 SEPTEMBER 2023 – 30 NOVEMBER 2023 (MAXIMUM OF EUR 20,000 FOR 2 YEARS)

- Africa-UniNet funds international research cooperation projects with at least one Austrian and at least one African university / university of applied sciences / research institution.
- Only active members of Africa-UniNet are eligible to apply.
- Minimum qualification for the project coordinator is a PhD. Contact persons and team members need to be at least PhD students
- The aim of the projects is to promote excellent research and to contribute to the SDGs.
- Different types of project activities can be submitted for funding:
- Joint work on research questions
- Joint development and implementation of research-based teaching and training
- Joint development and implementation of trainings, workshops, seminars, conferences, alumni meetings
- Joint work on publications
- Joint supervision of students
- Funding can only be provided for mobility costs; Exception: up to EUR 3,000 per project can be allocated to equipment and materials
